

## CARING FOR YOUR EMPTIER

( pinch emptier, manual kit )

Your new emptier is very reliable and requires little maintenance. Clean water is what we recommend for a daily flushing. You may use a germicide or vinegar as long as you flush with water last. Chlorine bleach should never be used.

The following should be incorporated into your end of day routine.

## VERY IMPORTANT!!

**FOLLOW TO THE LETTER OR YOUR WARRANTY WILL BE VOID!!!!**

### Shut Down Procedures

1. Empty the leg bag using the emptier.
2. Close the clamp or valve on the leg bag.
3. Remove the tubing from the emptier. (slip it out of the pinch mechanism)
4. Unplug the power from the emptier and remove the emptier and support band from the user's leg.
5. Unplug the barbed fitting with the emptier tubing from the leg bag tubing.
6. Wash the emptier tubing in the bathroom sink with fresh water. Reinsert the washed tubing into the emptiers pinch mechanism.

### Chair Servicing

- 1) Always have emptier installation instructions handy when service personnel arrive.
- 2) Always test emptier **BEFORE** battery cover is replaced.
- 3) Always **INSIST THAT EMPTIER WORK AS IT DID BEFORE.**

## TROUBLE SHOOTING

1. -Check that all connectors are plugged in properly.  
-Check that all wires are intact (including their attachment to the connectors) and not broken or bare.
2. -Check that the Power Bank connections are seated and that the Power Bank is charged.
6. -If the system still does not function please contact us. Please note that there are two 2A board mounted fuses within the adapter. These are not serviceable by the end user and must be checked and changed, if necessary, by us or by an electronics technician.
